## New York Law Requires Written Notice to Employees of Rates and Timing of Pay

Effective October 26, 2009, New York Labor Law § 195(1) requires employers to give <u>written</u> notice to employees hired on or after that date, at the time of hire, of certain wage information and to obtain a <u>written</u> acknowledgement from each new hire that he or she received such information. Under this law, employers need to provide written notice of the following:

- The rate of pay
- The overtime rate of pay (for non-exempt employees)
- The regular pay day

An employer must obtain written acknowledgement from each employee that he/she has been notified of the above information.

On October 28, 2009, the New York State Department of Labor released a form, which is available on its website<sup>1</sup> and is also attached to this alert, that employers must use as documentation of the written notice they provide to employees of their rates of pay, their pay dates and their overtime rates. This form must be provided to all new employees before they begin work. A duplicate signed copy of the form is to be given to the employee and the original must be kept by the employer for six years.
